TA in Portugal in the 80s and 90s

- TA activities in Portugal had recent important developments.
- A seminal work of João Caraça and Fernando Gonçalves with the title "Towards Technology Assessment in Portugal" was published in the 80s.
- Later, some specialized activities were basically the involvement in European networks and projects
 - As the European Technology Assessment Network (ETAN) established in the 4th Framework Programme of European R&D under the targeted socio-economical research area (TSER) in the topic "Assessment of science and technology policy options") and
 - The European ASTPP network (Advanced Science and Technology Policy Planning) also with the Portuguese participation, which was approaching the concept of technology assessment and its applications.

TA in Portugal since 2000

- The beginning of the new millennium was characterised with a less involvement on TA projects and activities.
- Therefore, it was a very rich period in terms of scientific production in the field of STS studies, or on topics about science and technology management, social implications of technology innovation, ethics and philosophy of technology issues.
- Scientific production is relatively disseminated by several Portuguese universities (mainly, UNovaLisbon, UTechLisbon, UPorto, UCoimbra, ISCTE, UÉvora, UMinho)
- Simultaneously, contacts and collaborations with research and high education institutions at an European level were increasing, becoming more important and clarifying the internationalisation capacity of the Portuguese scientific production in this field.

A new development phase of TA

- With the beginning of the PhD programme on Technology Assessment at FCT-UNovaLisboa in 2009, it started the creation of a critical mass of researchers with expert training on TA that contributed to the growth number of publications and activities.
- This PhD programme had the involvement and cooperation from Karlsruhe Institute of Technology, and also the Univ. Twente (Netherlands) and Univ. Frankfurt (Germany), since it started.
- In 2010 the Grupo de Estudos em Avaliação de Tecnologia [Studies Group on Technology Assessment] (GrEAT), the national TA network.
- In 2011 it started the participation in the European project on parliaments and civil society in the technology assessment (PACITA).

Institucionalization of TA in Portugal

- The Portuguese process to institutionalise TA shows clearly that the governmental mechanisms failed (observatories, special committees). It failed also the possibility to institutionalise a specific committee at the Parliament.
- GrEAT started the process of approaching the Parliament to articulate activities and collaborations. Several parliamentary groups (members, parties, commissions) are in a close and permanent contact with GrEAT members.
- It was never possible to activate TA mechanisms and institutions although the aims of several Observatories and Offices of the Ministry of Science and Technology (OCT, OCES or GPEARI) and the several National Boards of Science and Technology have pointed that way.
- Initiatives on TA research just can be resumed to the PhD programme on TA (at UNovaLisbon)

The PhD programme on TA

- First editon started in 2009/2010 (from October)
- 19 Phd students registered
- Research topics

 - A Constructive Technology Assessment of Stationary Energy Storage Systems (Manuel Baumann)

The relation with the Parliament

- After the foundation of GrEAT in 2010, the Portuguese Parliament was contacted for exchange of information
- In January 2011, a meeting at the Parliament was held with the head of the socialist parliamentary group (PS)
- From mid-2011 new elections, and new Parliament organisation: PS has no longer the majority, and became the main opposition party
- From the end of 2011, members of GrEAT started their regular collaboration with the PACITA project in articulation with ITAS-KIT
- The head of the Parliamentary Committe of Science and Education participates in the 2nd Winter School on TA (December 2011)
- New webpages and organisation of working groups
- Several publications from 2012
- In 2013 new series of contacts with several Parliament groups (some MoP will participate in the 3rd Doctoral Conference, July 2013)

Collaborative actions with the Parliament (under development)

Conclusive remarks

- The recent development of TA in Portugal is based on scientific framework of science and technology studies (STS), and emerges from the doctorate programme on TA.
- The interdisciplinary collaborations are increasing within all fields of human and social sciences and also natural sciences and engineering.
- Public events in the field of TA are also strongly connected with the PhD programme. There is a regular participation of members of Parliament and experts from all the country in those events. Those events are not merely academic.
- The cooperation with the Parliament initiated a new process (GrEAT is making available a new range of services, and MoP are participanting in the public debate related with TA activities).
- Joint activities (GrEAT/Parliament) will be incentivated and reported to EPTA
